Trip Report

South Africa, October 24 – November 8, 2012

The IBM Retirement Club travelers had a wonderful time in Africa! We went to South Africa and Zambia.
There is so much to see!!

Strangely, there was a bit of a language barrier even though we all claimed to be speaking English. Diversity is both South Africa's strength and its weakness. There is a two tier (maybe more) society based mostly on race, each tier with its own separate (and sometimes opposing) set of values and customs. They desperately need intelligent, honest, capable leadership. We heard estimates of more than 30% unemployment due perhaps to an experiment in outcome based education (OBE) instead of the time honored method of teaching the 3 R's, which may have led to a lack of trained workforce. This is a country blessed with enviable natural resources, including coal, gold, diamonds and platinum. Throughout northern South Africa, we saw stick-straight, closely planted (they trim the lower branches) pine forests, regularly harvested and replaced, which supply a good share of the world's paper.

And then there is the famed wildlife in both South Africa and Zambia. On safari, we saw cape buffalo, elephants, zebras, giraffes, rhinos, impala, wildebeest, waterbuck, hyenas, jackals, baboons, warhogs, monkeys, lions, leopard and cheetah. We saw fish eagles, herons, guinea fowl, ostrich, grouse, weaver birds, buzzards, vultures and even some creepy crawlies like chameleon and one black mamba snake (one was enough). We saw whales breaching on Walker Bay in the beautiful seaside resort town of Hermanus. We were treated to a wine tasting and picnic lunch at a winery in the Cape wine region. We enjoyed cruises on Lake St. Lucia, Hout Bay and the Zambezi river, and saw hippos, crocodiles, seals and penguins. We explored the beautiful Cape Town water front, and looked out over the city from the top of Table Mountain.

In Zambia, we walked to Victoria Falls. There has been a drought there and some of the water is diverted for power purposes, so we could see a good deal of the underlying basalt rock over which water is cascading during the wet times of the year. There was enough water for us to see "the smoke that thunders" -- the mist that hangs over the falls.

We were busy!!

On our last evening together we watched a crimson sun set over the Zambezi River -- a great memory to take home.

San Francisco Stairway Walk

Last time we did this walk everyone said it was most enjoyable, so we are doing it again. It is an urban trek, almost all on paved streets and walkways. But oh, what walkways these are! We will use the city's stairways to navigate hills that are too steep for cars. When we scouted the walk, we counted a total of 550 stairs going up, probably about the same going down. So bring your most comfortable walking shoes and tune up your knees for this challenging walk.

We found the walk in a delightful book called "Stairway Walks in San Francisco." Our route takes us through Golden Gate Heights, an area south of Golden Gate Park. It's a quiet residential neighborhood with a lovely park and great views.

Other than the stairways we'll navigate, your other challenge will be finding a place to park. We will be meeting on the corner of 15th and Lincoln, across the street from Golden Gate Park. We noted that there was available parking on Lincoln, with no time limit. Probably your best bet to get to the city will be the 280-19th Avenue route. When you get to Lincoln (just before Golden Gate Park), turn right and begin your search for a space. Carpooling is highly recommended! Carpoolers - meet at the normal place - Camden Park and Ride (Camden at 85), at 8:30 AM.

We didn't find a great place to stop for lunch along the walk, so we recommend bringing a snack and drink for munching along the way. Once we finish the walk there is a wide variety of restaurants nearby around 9th avenue (we'll direct you) where you can replenish the calories you burned.
