## 2014 IBM Health Plan Benefit

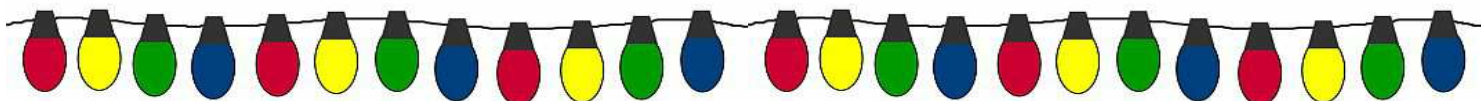
Dear IBM Retiree or Benefit Recipient,

I'm writing with an important message regarding your IBM healthcare coverage. I want to remind you that your current IBM group coverage for Medicare-eligible retirees ends on December 31, 2013. I urge you to take action now to enroll in health and prescription drug coverage for 2014.

If you have spoken with an Extend Health benefit advisor but not yet enrolled, I ask that you call Extend Health today to complete your enrollment in healthcare coverage for 2014. If you have not yet called Extend Health, please do so soon if you need coverage for 2014.

If you currently receive an IBM contribution toward your healthcare coverage, you need to take action to avoid losing that contribution in 2014. To qualify for that IBM contribution, you must call Extend Health and enroll in either a medical or prescription drug plan before December 31. Please call Extend Health today toll-free at 1-855-359-7380 to speak with one of their benefit advisors.
